During the period of January to December 2019, there was 22 LVE Workshops for Educators held in 12 cities in 8 provinces in Indonesia. Maluku, Bali, East Java, Central Java, Jogjakarta, West Java, Jakarta and South Sumatra was on the list.

As many as 38 LVE Accredited Trainers and 3 candidates of trainers took part in organizing and facilitating the Workshop.

29%

Increase in donor support for One Year Professional Program. We are trying to provide full scholarship which includes tuition fee, boarding and meal.

36%

Increase in Short Course program income. Mostly from English as second language, assisted with computer and multimedia short courses. We aim to have more classes next year, addressing children with fun English.

58%

Increase in overall revenue, with additional income from CL3 (Creating Life-Long Learning) department with in house training in Leadership from within workshop.

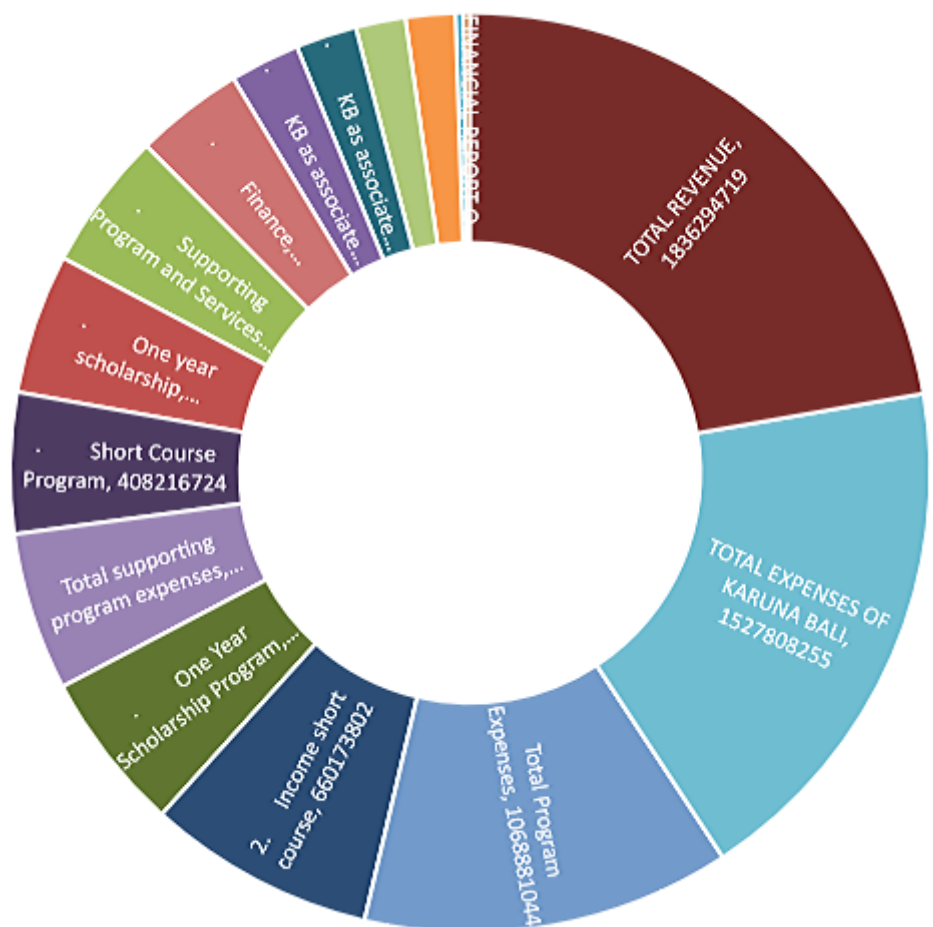
