The Learning-and-Exploring Dragonfly

After running a one-year youth scholarship program for 14 years, we decided to end the program in July 2021 after a deep reflection-evaluation and assessing the nowadays challenges of youth in Bali. On 7th July 2022, a scholarship pilot program for youth was launched. It is a 6-month program (preparation and implementation) and it is run under the care of Capung Melajah department.

Capung Melajah is a re-activated of previous department, Campuhan Life-Long Learning. Capung is Indonesian word for 'dragonfly'. 'Melajah' is a combination of two words: 'melajah', a Balinese word means to learn and 'jelajah', an Indonesian word mean to explore. This department with its new team has two sections: Youth Leadership and Life Skills (for public).
